## Y3 Crucible Visit Wednesday 8th November 2017

Dear Parent / Carer,

The Year 3 team are already looking forward to our next half term, when we will be learning all about the place of the arts in cultures around the world.

In order to provide opportunities for some hands on experience, we have arranged for the children to visit the Crucible Theatre for the day on **Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> November 2017**. As part of the day, children will participate in a drama workshop led by the Crucible staff, take a tour around the theatre and work towards gaining a Discover Arts Award which aims to help young people discover the arts in the world around them. These are really exciting opportunities for the children to get in touch with their creative side and understand the importance of the arts in our lives.

We will be leaving school **promptly** at 8.40am, so we ask that your children arrive by **8.30am** on the day of the trip. We will aim to be back by 3.20pm. **Your child will need a packed lunch** (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please) and may wish to bring a snack. It is essential that your child also wears a warm coat and sensible shoes as we will be walking to and from school. We would appreciate any parents who are able to help with walking with the children.

To cover the cost of the ticket, we need to ask for a voluntary contribution of £9.00 which must be paid through ParentPay (and may be paid in instalments of your choice) by Friday 27<sup>th</sup> October. Unfortunately, if we have not collected sufficient funds by Friday 27th October, the trip will be cancelled.

We are conscious of the degree of financial support that we ask parents for throughout the course of the year and as such this will be the principal cost that we ask for your help with this year. On the bottom of this letter is a table which indicates our current planned trips, as well as estimated times and approximate cost. Please note, this is subject to change and will be confirmed nearer the time.
