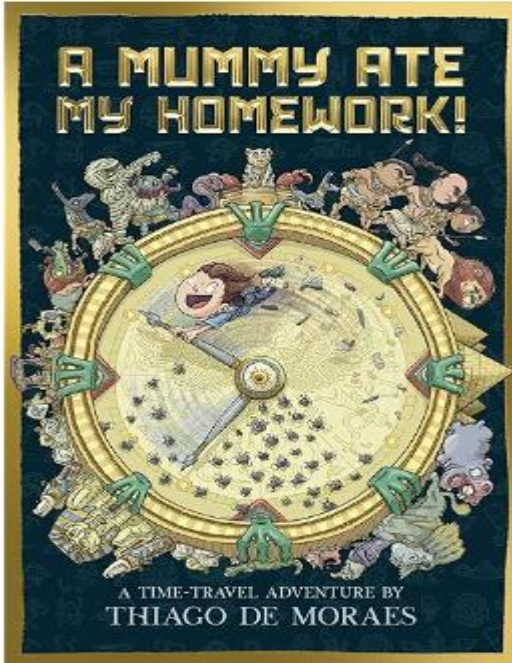

## Ways to help out at home

**Reading** – Read at home as much as possible, with, and to, your child. For the greatest gains, your child needs to be reading at home EVERY DAY!

Take it in turns to read a section of a book if they find it tiring.

Read a book that is too hard for your child to read by themselves so they can hear what a good reader sounds like.

**Writing** – Ask your child to write some sentences about what they have learned in school today. Encourage them to **think** of the sentence first, then **say** it aloud, **write** it then **read** what they have actually written. Does it match? Check that ALL sentences are accurately punctuated and make sense.

**Team time talk (Oracy)** – What is the most amazing/surprising/unusual/silly thing that you have learned today?

If you could change one thing about the day what would it be- it can be as daft as you like (I wish I'd worn different trousers/I wish I had eaten more breakfast)

**Maths** – We are doing well on number bonds but it never hurts to keep practising. Also we need to focus on our times tables starting with the 2x, 5x, 10x then moving on to the 3x, 4x, 8x.
