

## Sub Committee Remit: Pupil Discipline

Responsible to	Strategy and Resources Committee
Members (not less than 4 members of the full governing body	Any number of governors may be appointed to a pool from which 3 or 5 governors will meet when considering particular exclusions.
	It is recommended that Staff Governors are not normally members of the Pupil Discipline Committee as they may be perceived to have a conflict of interest.
	The Headteacher may not be a member of this committee
Quorum (at least 3)	3
Meeting Frequency	The committee will meet as and when required and within the timescale set
	down in the governing body's Complaints Policy and Procedures
Committee Chair	To be appointed when forming the committee

The Strategy and Resources Committee, who have delegated authority for all functions of the Governing body delegates the following functions to this sub-committee.

- To monitor and review the use of exclusion within the school
- To report to the Governing Body on the use of exclusion
- To consider pupil exclusions in line with current legislation.

In relation to policies, the Governing Body of Hunter's Bar Junior School has delegated it's policies to this committee, the Headteacher or individuals as detailed in the Policy Review Schedule approved in March 2016.
