Home-learning will be set by the class teacher and handed out to pupils on a Wednesday afternoon and will be expected back in school by the following Wednesday morning.

As the year progresses we may review and update our homework policy depending on the needs of the children. This may result in classes having a little extra homework on some weeks but the general pattern of homework will remain the same throughout the year.
