Y4 School Swimming Lessons

Dear Parents/Carers of Y4 children,

The Y4 children have swimming lessons at Ponds Forge. The children follow a syllabus based on the compulsory National Curriculum for Key Stage 2.

The first lesson for children are as follows:

J4 (Miss Stevens) 16th September 2016 J5 (Mr Jenkins) 23rd September 2016 J6 (Mr Beauchamp) 30th September 2016

We apologise for the late notice for J4.

A personalised programme of lessons for your child will be sent to you following the assessments. It is possible that your child's second lesson will be on 7th October. This will be confirmed as soon as possible after 30th September.

The children will travel to Ponds Forge by coach ready for their lesson at 2.10pm. Lessons finish at around 2.55pm and the coach should arrive back at school for normal finishing time. On occasion it may be a few minutes late due to traffic.

Your child will need to bring:

- Swimming costume/ trunks/swimming shorts (not a bikini please)*
- Towel
- A bottle of water
- A small bag to carry the above items

*A swimming costume, trunks or swimming shorts are highly recommended to make swimming as easy as possible. If this is an issue for you, costumes are available that cover more of the body, in shops & on the internet.

<u>No Jewellery is allowed</u> – not even sleeper earrings. If your child has recently had his/her ears pierced the ear rings must still be removed. This is a Sheffield City Council policy. We suggest children do not wear earrings on their swimming day, if they do they must be able to remove them themselves. School will not be responsible for any lost earrings.

Long hair must be tied back, or ideally a swimming cap worn.

Goggles <u>can</u> be worn if required. Parents must complete the below form. However, goggles <u>cannot</u> be worn during the first lesson when the children are being assessed.

<u>Inhalers</u>: If your son/daughter is asthmatic, s/he must take his/her inhaler with them. The same applies for other medication they might require, for example Epipens.
