Being named a team captain is quite the honour. The position of captain is given to those pupils whom the rest of the team respect and trust to lead the team in the right direction. It is expected that captain will maintain control if things are going wrong and be the model of excellence for their teammates.

A good captain should embody the 3 C's: *Caring, Courageous, and Consistent.*

Caring captains will put the success of the team ahead of their own needs. As a caring captain, you should treat all teammates with respect and recognise the contributions made by all team members.

Courageous captains set the example for the rest of the team. Your actions must embody the core values of the team, especially during times of adversity (if things are going wrong).

Consistent captains will give 100% effort in every training session and game.

Leaders are made and not born. Good captains will learn from others and follow examples of good leadership. These could be from past captains, older pupils or just from important adults.

One thing that all good captains need is good communication and oracy skills. At HBJS, captains will be asked to do a short match report during assembly. This example script can be used to help you plan what you need to say.
