We will not be making any wholescale changes to the system right now, but some small tweaks may be made as we continue.

Home Learning and Bank Holiday

We are aware that there are differences in both circumstances and need when it comes to the home learning. Bearing this in mind and following the principles set out for home learning; we would not expect children to be doing any work on Friday and to take it as a holiday. However, work has been provided for the week for those parents who would find it useful.

As usual, teachers will still selecting a piece of work to be shared with them and will communicate this in the same way and at the same time (by Thursday lunchtime). If you are taking Friday off, please don't feel under any obligation to do this for this week – simply choose another piece of work to send (your child might want to choose something they are particularly proud of).

Moving forwards

We continue to wait for news form the Government about any easing or changes to the lockdown procedures. Our school has been working with other local schools, with support from the Local Authority to look at different scenarios based on some or all of the children returning to school. If things change either nationally or locally, we will let you know as soon as we do.
