

Y6 THORNBRIDGE RESIDENTIAL VISIT 2019

WHAT TO TAKE

- A packed lunch and drink (not in a glass bottle) for the first day only
- Any medication including inhalers if used (please ensure that your child's medication is clearly labelled and handed to Mrs Blacksell (our designated lead First Aider) by the day of departure.
- Pyjamas / nightie
- Toiletries, e.g. towel, soap, toothbrush and toothpaste
- Brush / comb
- Slippers / indoor shoes
- Sensible shoes or trainers - no sandals or open toed shoes.
- Thornbridge will supply each child with a waterproof coat that goes below the knees and wellies for the 3 days the children are there. It is still important your child has a coat.
- It is best to wear old, comfortable clothing, as they may get dirty. No school uniform is needed. We suggest 2 changes of clothes in addition to what your child will be wearing on the first day.
- The key factor is to insure your child is warm, we suggest the following: warm socks (2 pairs), layers, fleece or sweatshirt, warm coat or jacket, long trousers (jeans are fine), gloves, warm hat.

OPTIONAL EXTRAS

- Cameras (this will be the responsibility of your child), though not a phone with a camera on - see below.
- A cuddly toy (if wanted) / small game (not electronic) and / or book
- Torch

WHAT NOT TO TAKE

- Mobile phones
- Sweets or chocolate
- DS/ MP3 players / Electronic toys
- Spending money - since there is no shop
