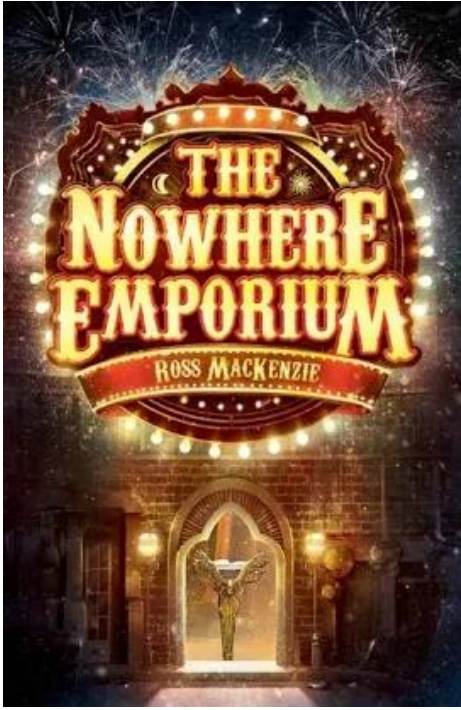

**Ways to help out at home**

**Reading** – As pupils come to the end of their time at our school, it remains vital that they maintain a daily reading habit at home each day, including over the summer holidays. Rhyme & Reason always have great recommendations if you need some inspiration!

**Tea time talk (Oracy)** – How are you feeling about the transition to secondary school? What sort of things are you looking forward to? What new challenges might be ahead? What will you be sad to leave behind?

**Secondary transition** – Apart from talking to your children about how they are feeling about this important transition, take some time to discuss and plan any practical considerations such as organising belongings, managing morning routines with more independence and what travelling to school will be like. This last half term is an ideal time to start encouraging your child to come to school on their own or with a group of friends (even if you have younger siblings that you drop off). If you require your child to have a mobile phone to support with this, please ensure you have read and signed our school’s mobile phone policy, available from the office or on our website.

**PSHE** – Discuss what prejudice is and how it affects different people’s lives. What is the right thing to do when we see prejudice happening? This is an important conversation to have in the run up to starting secondary school.

**Science** – Ask your child to show you their understanding of series and parallel circuits using the online circuit builder <http://www.physicstutoronline.co.uk/electric-circuits-simulation/> What types of circuits can you make?
