- 1 We can make choices to protect the rainforest through the products we buy.
- 2 Animals and plants can be classified (sorted) by looking at their features.
- 3 Deforestation is the action of clearing a wide area of trees.
- 4 Some mammals, birds, reptiles and amphibians are losing their habitat because of deforestation.
- Rainforests are often called 'the lungs of the world' because they are believed to be responsible for producing 20% of the world's oxygen.
- 6 There are groups of people who are trying to save the rainforests.
- 7 The rainforests are in danger because lots of the food and drinks we consume, medicines that make us better etc. contain products that come from the rainforest.
- 8 The water cycle describes the continuous movement of water on, above and below the surface of the Earth.
