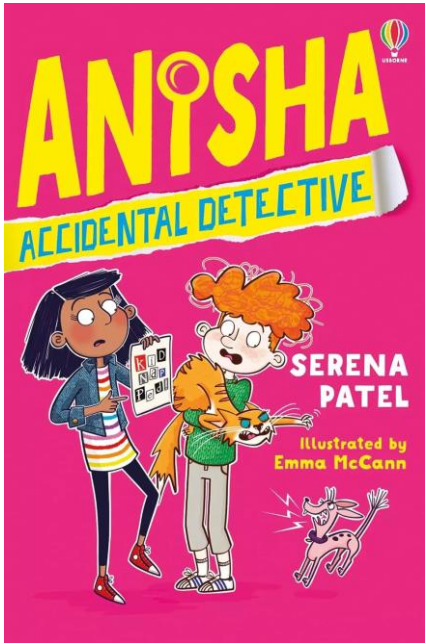

Ways to help out at home:

Reading – Read at home as much as possible, with, and to, your child. Occasionally, re-read texts or part of texts – this helps fluency and understanding. Could your child start to read a range of genres? This helps their writing as well as reading.

Writing – Writing is always a more difficult subject to help with at home. BUT, if your child is writing anything, encourage them to write using a range of sentence types – we have looked at simple, compound and complex sentences now.
