1	Mood	Mood describes an overall feeling. This mood of this painting is angry. What is the mood of this piece of music?
2	Connect	To make a link between things. The handle is connected to the door. The oboe and the duck are connected.
3	Appreciate	To understand the importance of something. I appreciate how beautiful this art it.
4	Confident	To feel sure about something.
5	Voice projection	To throw your voice forward so the audience can hear you.
6	Explore	To search and discover.
7	Express	To show a thought or feeling. I have used this colour to express happiness.
8	Community	All the people living in an area who share common interests e.g. your school.
9	Identity	Identity is what makes one person or group different from others.
10	Communicate	To share or exchange information or ideas.
