Dear Parent / Carer

As part of our "How we Express Ourselves" theme - in which we will be studying Peter and the Wolf- we have two exciting opportunities for our Y3 pupils.

The first is a trip to the **City Hall** to listen to the **Halle Orchestra** perform. The trip will take place on **Friday 6th March 2020**. We will be walking to the venue and plan to leave school around 9.30am and return to school for the afternoon as normal. The Halle is an award winning professional orchestra that performs throughout the UK and internationally. It has its own record label and is considered the North's premier orchestra. The cost for this trip is £3.50.

Your child will need a packed lunch (no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please) and may wish to bring a snack. It is essential that your child has a coat that day and wears sensible shoes as we have a long walk and the weather is often unpredictable in March. If you would like to accompany us on the walk to and from City Hall and attend the concert with us please indicate this on the reply slip. Unfortunately, we only have a limited number of places available due to ticket numbers and can not guarantee spaces for everyone.

The second is a performance at a Singing Festival on Friday 27th March 2020. This will take place at Firth Hall, The University of Sheffield, Western Bank, S10 2TN. The performance will take place at 14.30 finishing at 15.10. Each child will be allocated one ticket for an adult to come and watch the concert. We will walk to the University and the children will then either leave the University to go home with their attending adults or, in the case of no adult attending for a
