WHAT TO TAKE

- ✓ **A packed lunch and drink (not in a glass bottle) for the first day**
- ✓ Any medication including inhalers if used (please ensure that your child's medication is clearly labelled and handed to class teacher: or our designated lead First Aider on the day of departure).
- ✓ Pyjamas / nightie
- ✓ Towel, soap, toothbrush and toothpaste
- ✓ Brush / comb
- ✓ Slippers / indoor shoes
- ✓ At least one change of clothing
- ✓ **Warm clothing and waterproof coat for walking**
- ✓ **Sturdy shoes or wellington boots for walking (old trainers may also be appropriate if there has not been too much rainfall).**
- ✓ A small rucksack / bag; so a packed lunch can be carried on the walk
- ✓ A cuddly toy (if wanted) / small game (not electronic) and / or book

OPTIONAL EXTRAS

Cameras (this will be the responsibility of you and your child, if it is a disposable camera please ensure your child's name is on it).

WHAT NOT TO TAKE

- X Mobile phones
- X Sweets or chocolate
- X DS/ MP3 players / Electronic toys
