Ways to help out at home

Reading – Read at home as much as possible, with, and to, your child. For the greatest gains, your child needs to be reading at home EVERY DAY!

Writing – Write a diary entry about an event you have witnessed. Encourage them to **think** of the sentence first, then **say** it aloud, **write** it then **read** what they have actually written. Does it match? Check that ALL sentences are accurately punctuated and make sense.

Team time talk (Oracy) - What happened in your class novel today? Tell me about something special that happened in your day today? What mark out of ten would you give your day today? Why that score? Tell me something funny that happened today? Can you tell me one thing you learned about in your _____ lesson?

Maths – Practise all of the times tables learned in Y4. Quiz your child daily for 5 minutes to help them retrieve these important facts.

PSHE – Discuss how we can keep safe online. Do you remember what SMART stands for?
