<u>Update on school position – 20.05.2020</u>

I hope that you all continue to be safe and well during this difficult time.

As you are probably aware, there is still much confusion and concern about plans to widen the access to school for Reception, Y1 and Y6 pupils, as well as changes in guidance for vulnerable pupils and pupils of key workers.

Alongside the national debate, Sheffield City Council have been meeting to discuss the city's response and: last night they released a statement for schools clarifying their position.

Meanwhile, we have been drawing up plans for different eventualities, considering risk assessments and consulting with other school leaders and experts about the best way forward.

I am mindful of providing sufficient information to keep you abreast of any changes whilst not overwhelming you with too much detail. Therefore, this is the first of two letters providing some information about next half term. On Friday we will share details of our risk assessment for school and also seek your views, so we can best support you in making decisions.

May Half Term Holiday

Just a reminder that the school will be closed on Monday 25th May (Bank Holiday), but open for the rest of the week for vulnerable pupils and pupils of key workers only.

Key Workers and Vulnerable Children

From 1st June, school will continue to be open to priority groups (<u>vulnerable</u> children and children of critical workers).

"Now that we have made progress in reducing the transmission of coronavirus we are encouraging all eligible children to attend - it is no longer necessary for parents of eligible children to keep them at home if they can. In particular, as per the
