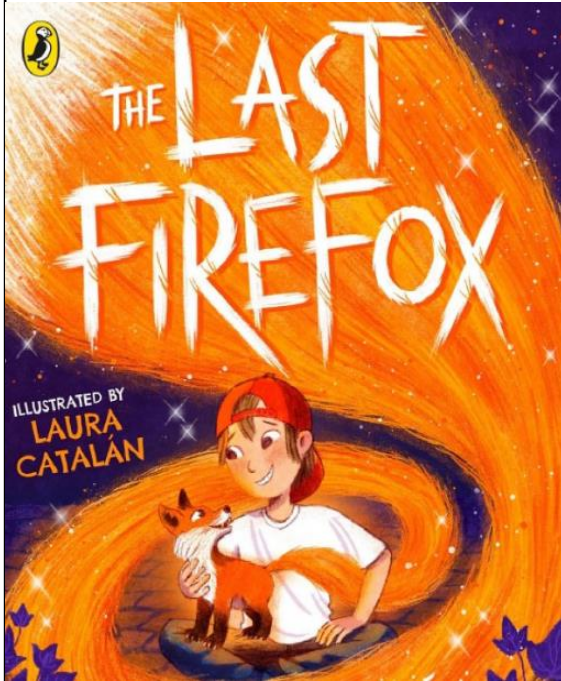

Ways to help out at home

Reading – Read at home as much as possible, with, and to, your child. For the greatest gains, your child needs to be reading at home EVERY DAY! Even children who can read well can still benefit from hearing an excellent reader (you!). Remember you can borrow books from the local library and the school library.

Tea time talk (Oracy) – Spend 10 minutes talking whilst you are all sitting round the table. What happened in your class novel today? Tell me about something special that happened in your day today? What mark out of ten would you give your day today? Why that score? Tell me something funny that happened today? Can you tell me one thing you learned about in your science/history/geography/ R.E. lesson? What did you play at playtime?

Maths – Our focus is on learning the 2 x 3x 5x and 10 x tables. Use TTRs at home to help make these facts easy to remember. Can you go beyond and learn the 4x or 6 x ?
